- I, Michael Anthony Kelly, of 111 George Street Brisbane in the State of Queensland, do solemnly and sincerely declare that:
 - 1. I refer to my statement of 27 September 2013 at paragraph 76 and say that since providing that statement I have reviewed further documentation provided to me by crown law relevant to this issue. I am now able to say that it appears that on 23 October 2008, a copy of the ASIC letter was sent to me as an attachment to an email from David Ford at 3.34pm.
 - 2. The documentation indicates that I then received an email from Lachlan Smith at 3.52pm on 23 October 2008 in which I was invited to discuss this issue. My recollection is that I did discuss the matter with Lachlan Smith and then, as requested by David Ford drafted a form of words for a proposed statement to reflect my understanding of the discussions with Lachlan Smith and earlier discussions I had had with David Ford and Lachlan Smith following the briefing from ASIC on 17 October 2008.
 - 3. It seems that I then sent the draft ministerial statement to David Ford at 5.25pm on 23 October 2008 noting "I have attached a rough one that the Min's office will no doubt want to amend after you have made any changes you think appropriate."
 - 4. At 10.21 am on 28 October 2008 Lachlan Smith sent an email to myself, Carol Perrett and David Ford informing us that the Treasurer had made a statement in Parliament and tabled the ASIC letter. The details of the ministerial were given.
 - 5. I replied at 10.25am and Lachlan Smith replied at 11.01am informing me that he had spoken Mr Bentley and requested someone from the office of racing should also call Mr Bentley.
 - 6. My recollection is that I spoke to Mr Bentley shortly afterwards and informed him that if he wanted to pursue changes to the QRL constitution, he would have to commence the whole process again. However, I informed Mr Bentley that I thought it would be highly unlikely that the Minister would consider any request to remove independent recruitment consultants for the appointment of directors.
